Acts 2:1-21, John 14:16-17, 14:26, 15:26-27

Prison Scene (used as common home scene), City Street Scene, Matthew (20), James (21), Philip (23), Peter (29), Andrew (40), Thomas (54), John (56), Mark (58), Men (87), Mary (94), Women (97A), Martha (104), Children (108), Tongues of Fire (267)

1. **Jesus told His disciples to wait for the Holy Spirit.** *Display Prison Scene (used as common home scene), Matthew, James, Philip, Peter, Andrew, Thomas, John, Mark, Mary, Martha.*
 - A. Jesus said, "The Holy Spirit will help you tell everyone that I am alive."
 - B. Jesus' disciples are in a room, waiting for the Holy Spirit to come.

2. **Suddenly, there is a sound from heaven like a mighty wind.** *Add Tongues of Fire.*
 - A. Tongues of fire come and sit upon each disciple.
 - B. The disciples are filled with the Holy Spirit.
 - C. The Holy Spirit is helping them to speak in other tongues.

3. **A large crowd gathers outside of the house where the disciples are.** *Display City Street Scene, Men, Women, Children - Move and Add Peter.*
 - A. They heard the sound of the Holy Spirit coming.
 - B. Peter tells them that Jesus sent the Holy Spirit.
 - C. Many people believe in Jesus and receive the Holy Spirit.

4. **Jesus wants you to be filled with the Holy Spirit.**
 - A. The Holy Spirit is Someone just like Jesus.
 - B. Everyone will see the power and presence of the Holy Spirit in your life.



The disciples were all filled with the Holy Spirit


Kurt






NUTMEG: What happened?

Just Like Jesus


Can you tell me . . . who is Someone just like Jesus?
